

AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS VINTAGE MAGNET



The information presented here may be changed by the district at any time. The number of spots available is also dependent on the number of coaches provided by the district for each program.

WE HAVE 2 AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAMS AVAILABLE: BOTH PROGRAMS ARE OVERSEEN BY COACH ANDREW MATAMOROS

After School Playground - Also known as Youth Services (YS)

- Available only to students in Grades 2-5
- Parents of students who will participate in YS starting the first day of school need to turn in a YS Application as soon as possible, so the coach will know which students to expect on the first day.

Youth Development Program (YDP)

- Available to students in grades K-5
- YDP is limited to 100 spots
- Priority will be given to applicants in Kindergarten and first grade because there is no other after school option for them.
- Parents interested in the YDP program will need to complete the YDP Lottery Entry Form and return it to Vintage by 4:00 p.m. Thursday, August 5, 2021.

After School Playground - Also known as Youth Services (YS)

- The district provides 1 to 2 coaches to supervise all the students who stay on After School Playground
- Parents may pick up students at any time before 6 PM daily
- There is no sign out process for parents when picking up their child

Youth Development Program (YDP)

- The district provides 4 coaches (1 coach for every 25 students)
- This program is designed for working parents, so a minimum of 80% attendance is required to participate.
- Parents must sign out their child between 5:45-6:00 daily

BOTH YS AND YDP WILL PROVIDE

- A hot supper served after school
- Physical activity on the playground
- Time for students to work on their homework
 - Please note that this is not a tutoring program. Parents are responsible for making sure their kids complete their homework as assigned.
- YDP in the past has also included a daily read aloud and traveling programs where the kids are taught other skills like coding.

TO APPLY FOR YS OR YDP

After School Playground - Also known as Youth Services (YS)

- Complete the After School Playground – Youth Services Application and return it to Vintage as soon as possible

Youth Development Program (YDP)

- YDP Lottery Forms are due Thursday, August 5, 2021, in the main office by 4:00 p.m. After Kindergarten and first grade spots are assigned, the number of spots available at each grade level will be determined.

YDP LOTTERY

- A public lottery will be held on Friday, August 6th at 3:00P.M. via Zoom to award the remaining spots. Parents are welcome to attend. Zoom ID: **915 0211 4855** Passcode: **Vintage**
- Students who are not accepted into the program will be added to the waiting list in the order that their names were drawn. Parents will receive notification of their status of accepted or on the waiting list by a phone call on Friday, August 6 at 7:00 P.M.
- Parents of students who were accepted must confirm that they will keep the YDP spot by 4:00 P.M. on Monday, August 9 on a Google Form that will be included in their email message. For students whose parents don't confirm by this time, the student will be dropped, and their YDP spot will be given to the next eligible student on the waiting list.
- If you are interested in having your child attend the YDP program for the 2021/2022 school year, please pick up an application in the school office and return it to Vintage by Thursday, August 5 at 4:00 P.M. Applications may also be emailed to new5993@lausd.net by the deadline.
