

Regular Dismissal Procedures for Students



- We ask that all parents complete the Google Form stating what their child's regular dismissal will be. This information will be given to the teacher so that they know where to direct the students.

- Any change to their regular procedure needs to be sent in writing. Please communicate directly with the teacher, and the teacher will then share that information with the office daily.



Dismissal Options

1. **Carpool Gate:** located on Densmore St. It is the gate next to the Kindergarten yard.
2. **Sibling Gate:** located on Septo St. in front of the play structure
3. **Bus:** All students who take the bus after school will be exit through the front of the school, as all of the buses will park on Stare St.
4. **After School Playground (YS):** Grades 2-5 only
5. **Youth Development Program (YDP):** Grades K-5
The lottery on Aug. 6th will determine which students will be in YDP.

1. Carpool Gate:

Students getting picked up at the Carpool Gate are:

1. All students in Kindergarten. We don't want the Kindergarten students to get lost, so all students that have a sibling in our Kindergarten will meet them at the Carpool Gate.
2. Students in Gr. 1 & 2 who do not have a sibling in grades 3-5 at Vintage.

2. Sibling Gate:

Students getting picked up at the Sibling Gate are:

1. Students in Grades 3-5 (unless they are going to meet their sibling in Kindergarten)
2. Students in Gr. 1 & 2 who have a sibling in grades 3-5 at Vintage.

3. Bus:

All students who live outside of a 2 mile radius of Vintage will qualify for bus transportation. Whether a student qualifies is determined by the Transportation Branch.

- The Transportation Branch will send your child's bus information in US mail the week before school starts. It will tell you the bus route number, the name of the bus stop, and the pick-up and drop off times.

3. Bus:

All students who will ride the bus after school will exit through the front entrance of the school, no matter the grade.

- The front of the school is a No Parking Zone during school days, because that is where our school buses load and unload.
- For bus issues, please call dispatch at 1(800) LA-BUSES.
- If you will pick up your child on a specific day instead of having them ride the bus, they will wait for you at the appropriate gate (Carpool or Sibling Gate). Students may not wait for parents in any other area.

3. Bus:

- Students who ride the bus after school will be given a wrist band with their bus number that they will need to wear during the first week of school. This will help our personnel make sure they get on the correct bus. Please do not cut it off until they come back home on Aug. 20th.



3. Bus:

- We share our buses with Balboa Magnet. Some buses stop at Vintage first and then go to Balboa Magnet, and visa versa. It is important that your child knows that their school is Vintage, so that they don't get off at Balboa Magnet instead.
 - Some students will get on the buses right after the bell rings. The others will wait at the assigned lunch tables for about 10-15 minutes while their buses to come from Balboa Magnet.
- The buses tend to arrive late at their bus stops after school during the first 2 weeks of school, as it takes time for us to make sure each child gets on the correct bus.

4. After School Playground (YS): Grades 2-5

- For information on the After School Playground, otherwise known as Youth Services (YS) be view the presentation on our school website, vintagemagnet.net. The application for YS will also be available there.
- YS is available until 6:00 p.m. daily, no matter what the school day dismissal is.

5. Youth Development Program (YDP): Grades K-5

- The lottery on Aug. 6th will determine which students will be in YDP.
- For information on the **Youth Development Program (YDP)** please view the presentation on after school programs on our school website, vintagemagnet.net. The YDP Lottery Entry Form will also be available there.
- Parents must pick up their kids from YDP between 5:45-6:00 p.m. daily, no matter what the school day dismissal is.

First Day Of School

- Where Should My Child Be in the Morning?
 - All Kindergarten and 1st Grade students– Auditorium
 - New students to Vintage in 2nd-5th Grades – Lunch Pavilion
 - Those who were Vintage students last year, even if you stayed online the whole year, will go to the yard to line up with last year's class. Returning students should look for the sign that has the name of their teacher from last year.
- Starting the second day of school, students will go to their line on the yard for this year's class.

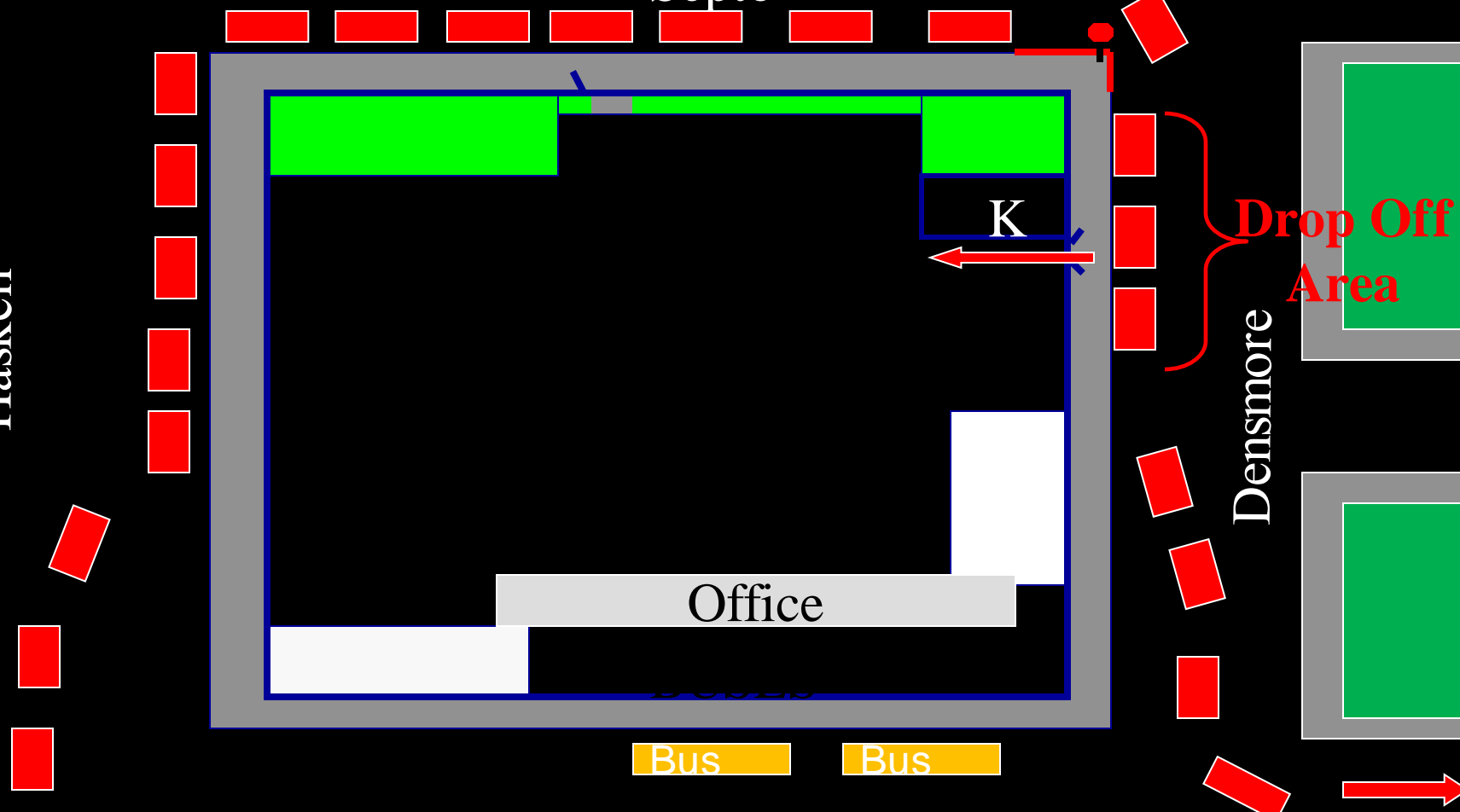

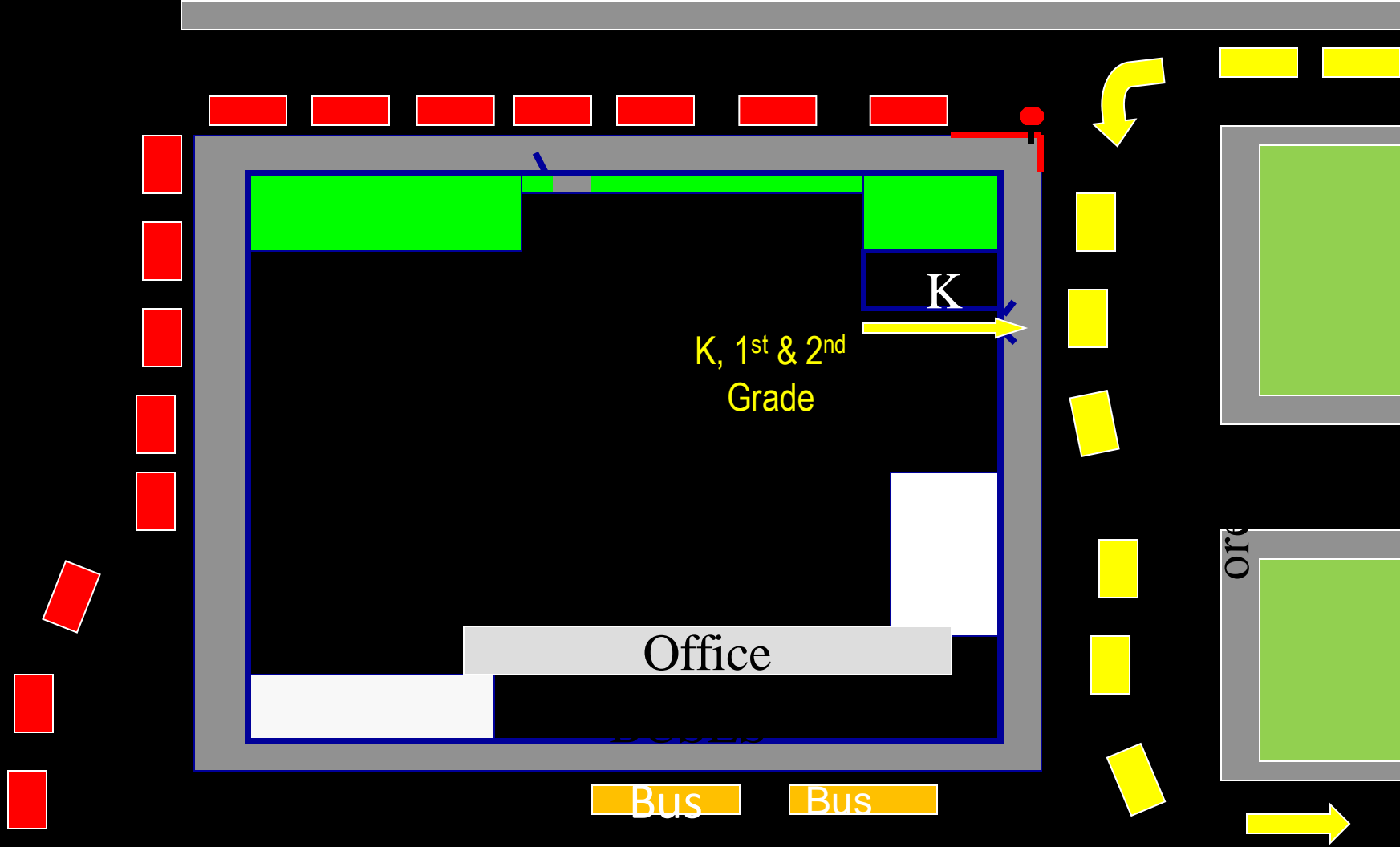
