Solid White or Navy Blue Shirts or Blouses	No shirts with logos, pictures, writing, prints or stripes

Code of Conduct

General School Rules

Stay in areas where there is adult supervision.

Halls

Walk facing forward

Include everyone

Auditorium

Walk at all times in the auditorium
Keep your feet off the chair in front of you
Enter the auditorium quietly
Applaud appropriately
Sit with your class
Raise your hand to ask to get up or use the restroom
Keep food out of the auditorium

Restrooms

Walk at all times in and around the restrooms
Keep your feet on the floor
Keep water in the sinks
Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself
Give people privacy
Flush the toilet after use
Throw paper towels in the trash can

Use bathroom properly

Lunch Area

Walk at all times in the lunch area
Sit with your feet on the floor and facing the table
Eat your own food
Keep food on your tray
Use good manners when eating
Use quiet voices
Line up and walk to the yard quietly
Observe the yellow flag—5 minute warning-stop talking and finish your lunch
Put trash in appropriate recycling bins
Leave eating area clean
Recycle properly

After School

Walk at all times after school
Stay with your assigned lines at all times
Always stay where there is adult supervision
Use calm voices
Late bus students need to stay seated while waiting
Stay in your assigned line
The restrooms are off limits
Food can be eaten only in the lunch pavilion with after-school coaches

Check with the coach before leaving the playground.

Always follow directions given by adults

Before School Supervision

Student may not arrive before 7:45 am because there is no adult supervision until then.

After School Supervision

2nd—5th grade students may go on the Youth Services (YS) after school program until 5:30pm

1st grade students must be picked up after school by 3:00 pm on regular days and 2:00 pm on banked days unless they are in the Youth Development Program (YDP)

Kindergarten students must be picked up after school by 3:00 pm on regular days and 2:00 pm on banked days.
